

## ***FIT*** lesson plan

**Subject area:** PSHE

**Key Stage:** 4

**Learning objectives:** To realise attitudes towards sexual orientation and how those can change when we learn more about lesbian, gay and bisexual people.

**Key Words:** lesbian – gay - bisexual – bullying – stereotypes – prejudices - context

### **Lesson outline**

	<b>Time</b>	
<b>Starter</b>	10'	Students individually complete Attitude Survey 'My attitudes towards sexual orientation'. Ask them to seal these in an envelope. (After seeing all chapters of FIT, ask them to complete a fresh copy of the Attitude Survey. They can then compare their attitudes with those they held before seeing the film.)
<b>Main Part</b>	30'	Watch FIT 'Dance and Drama' and 'Lee'
	10'	Ask students to complete another survey 'My attitudes towards sexual orientation'.
<b>Plenary</b>	10'	<p>Compare the difference between the before and after surveys. Discuss differences between students. (see teachers' notes on survey)</p> <p>Ask students whether they have developed any new ideas in the course of the session.</p> <p>This can be repeated with the other FIT chapters and before and after watching all video diaries.</p>
